APPENDIX TO THE NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE ISSUED VIDE CERTIFICATE  
NO. 15 POC 95, DATED: 01-03-1995.

- 1) The Management shall get the recognition granted to it by the State Government even after the school gets affiliated to the CBSE, until it gets permanent recognition from the State Govt.,
- 2) The Management shall subject itself to the over all control, Superintendence, Inspection of the State Education Department. The management shall submit its annual audited statements of accounts of Income and Expenditure to Govt. every year along with application seeking renewal of recognition, and get approval on the same.
- 3) The State Education Department shall be competent to hold enquiry and take appropriate disciplinary action against the management in cases of complaints against the management.
- 4) The management shall not collect any donation from the students or their parents/Guardians and collect only fees as prescribed by Govt. from time to time as per the provisions of the Karnataka Educational Institutions (Abolition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1984.
- 5) The management shall appoint only qualified staff conforming to the qualifications prescribed to the posts by the CBSE and get approval of the State Govt. in respect of each appointment made. There should be a written agreement between the management and each employee with regard to the nature of appointment, service conditions, pay and allowances, retirement benefits etc., and copies of such agreement shall be available with both the management and the employee concerned.
- 6) The management shall pay to its staff at a rate not lower than that paid by the Central Government to the corresponding central staff.
- 7) No teacher/staff shall be removed from service without a proper inquiry as prescribed in respect of an employee of a state aided educational institution and prior approval of the D.P.I. concerned should be obtained before such removal.
- 8) Service conditions of employees under the management shall be fully protected as in the case of an employee of state aided educational institution.
- 9) Children of employees of All India Services; Central Government Services liable to inter-state transfer; migrants from out of state who are temporarily put up in this state; Employees of All India level Business/Commercial/Industrial establishments; and Anglo Indians shall get preference in admission.
- 10) Ten percent of the admission in each class may be filled up at the discretion of the Education Department Authorities not below the rank of jurisdictional D.P.I. The Jurisdictional D.P.I. may issue directions in respect of such of the deserving students.
- 11) Any other condition that may be imposed in future.
- 12) The NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE along with the conditions subject to which the same has been issued should be exhibited in a conspicuous place in the chambers of the principal/head master/head mistress, for the benefit of general public.
